


## UP A GRACEFUL STAIRCASE, THE MAIN SLEEPING QUARTERS CAN BE FOUND.

Two generous bedrooms are separated by a full Jack and Jill bathroom, each with their own granite topped wash basins. Down the hall, the master bedroom looks out toward the lake, and vaulted ceilings create an airy aesthetic. A private balcony is a special feature in which to take in water views. The en suite bath is clad in travertine and connects to a spacious walk-in closet with ample storage. Thoughtfully designed for modern living, the laundry room is just off the upstairs landing.

The lower level of the home features high ceilings and a well-sized media room for recreational enjoyment. A large bedroom and full bathroom create additional accommodations for guests.
