IN A TREE-LINED NEIGHBORHOOD AND JUST A FEW SHORT BLOCKS FROM MOUNT BAKER PARK, THIS 1929 TUDOR COMMANDS AN ELEGANT CORNER PRESENCE.

Sitting just above street level, the home is bordered by a charming rock wall and gorgeously maintained gardens that wrap the property in gentle verdant privacy. Vintage wrought iron gates usher you through the flower-lined pathways under the canopy of 100 year old Japanese maples.











THROUGH THE MAIN ENTRANCE, A FORMAL ENTRY IS OPEN AND INVITING WITH A STAIRCASE TO THE UPPER LEVEL OF THE HOME AND EASY PASSAGE TO THE FORMAL LIVING SPACE, DINING ROOM AND KITCHEN.

A small step leads to the sunken living room, dramatically showcasing 15' ceiling with original beams and spectacular original leaded and stained glass windows that look out to the gardens beyond. A grand fireplace and period sconces cultivate a feeling of warmth and other-worldliness.

Cream cabinetry is offset by dark granite countertops and classic marble subway tile backsplash. A farmhouse kitchen door leads to a private outdoor patio wrapped in mature plantings, with a wandering path through the back garden area. A 3/4 bath and bedroom complete the main floor.
